I want to express my complete satisfaction and compliment you for your "RIDE ON" product. As a motorcycle rider, in my case, "Ride On" has proven to be among the best safety products I have ever used on my motorcycle(s).

After reading Larry Grodsky article in Rider, I found a dealer offering the product. I had it installed in my tires just before leaving for a coast to coast (Daytona Beach, FL to San Bernardino, CA and return to North Carolina) trip last October. During this trip, I first picked up a nail in my rear tire in Arizona. I followed the instructions given to me, and the puncture was sealed with a loss of only about 3 pounds of air. Again in Arizona, on Route 66, during a fueling stop, inspecting the tire, I discovered a sheet metal screw. Again, following instructions, I unscrewed the screw, immediately rode the bike a couple of miles, stopped to inspect the tire, and the puncture was sealed with a minimal loss of air. I am still using this tire, nearly 8K miles later without any other repair.


I also had a tread separation on a front tire, due to a manufacturing defect. When I discovered the knot, I noticed the "Ride On" product had sealed around the area where the tire tread had actually separated.

In my opinion, "Ride On" is the best flat prevention product on the market. For the touring motorcyclist the peace of mind alone is well worth the investment. I am a believer in the "Ride On" product and am spreading the word to other motorcyclist and every dealer I encounter. I am amazed so few dealer have heard of "Ride On".
