It is not very often that I write a letter of praise for products that we routinely use in our maintenance facility. However, this time I must make an exception and write you to let you know that your product (Ride-on TPS) really works as you claim.

Nine months ago I saw one of your advertisements in a waste related magazine, and with a bit of skepticism I called to get some information about Ride-On TPS. Since Hart County was about to take delivery of our brand new International trash trucks and roll-off, I thought it might be a good idea to start a new tire maintenance program.
